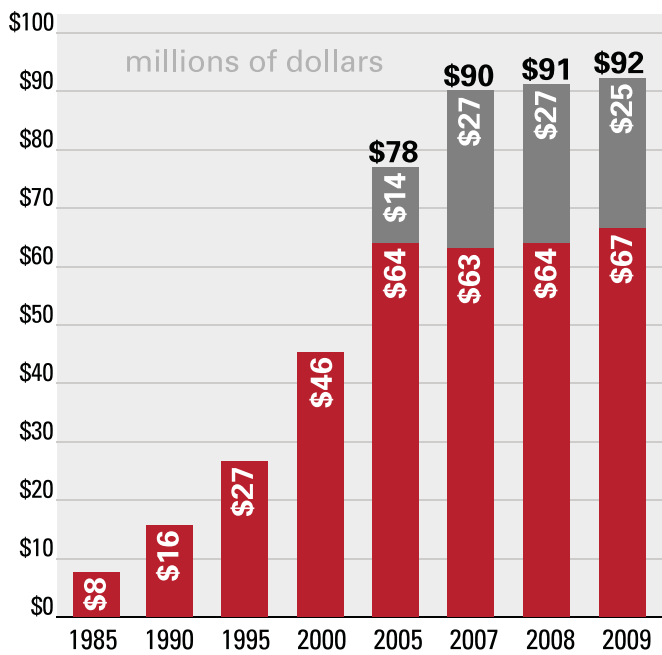
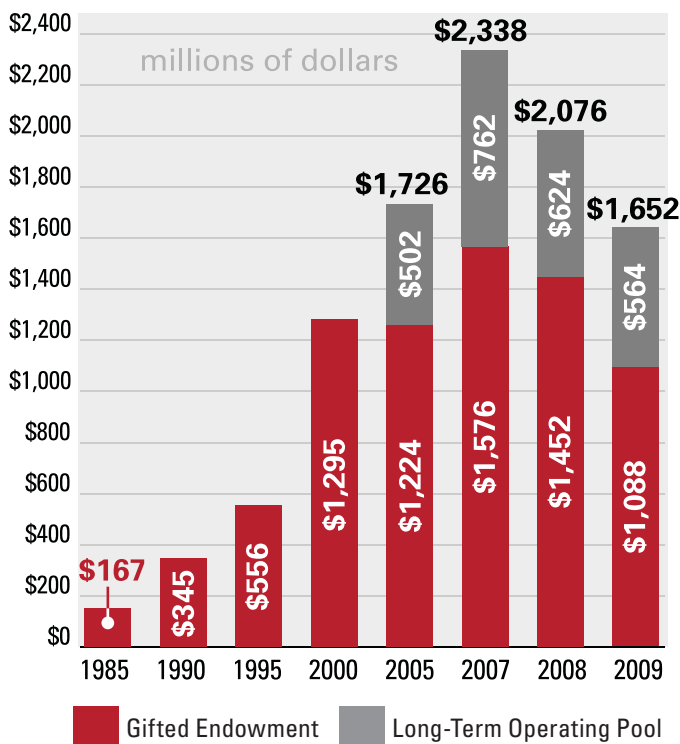


Ohio State has 4,280 endowments funds, many of which are named to honor or memorialize someone loved and respected. Endowments advance excellent people and programs at Ohio State by providing them with substantial funding on a permanent, consistent basis. Endowed gifts to Ohio State are invested in the University Long-Term Investment Pool, which is managed by the Office of Investments much like a mutual fund. The gifts are invested in perpetuity, and their annual distribution then goes toward a purpose as specified by the donor. In this way, an endowed gift makes a tremendous difference to the entire university community for countless years to come.

Historical Long-Term Investment Pool Distribution

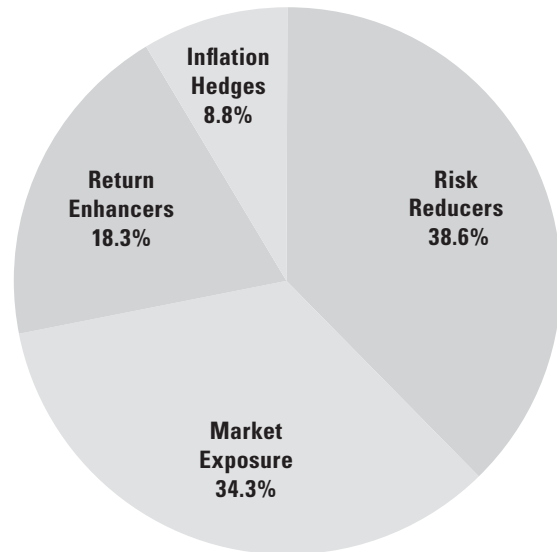


Historical Long-Term Investment Pool Market Value



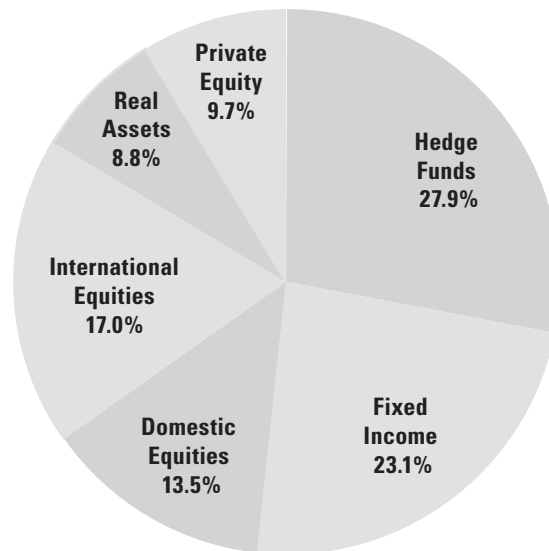
Current Asset Allocation Model

In June 2009, the Board of Trustees approved a new, more flexible asset allocation for the University's Long-Term Investment Pool. The previous policy segmented the approved and investible assets into six categories which included domestic equities, international equities, fixed income, hedge funds, private equities, and real assets (including real estate, energy, commodities, and agriculture).

The new policy was designed to allow for more flexibility and better risk and liquidity management, as well as to provide a greater degree of opportunism in the day-to-day management of the fund. The new asset categories under the new policy consist of **Market Exposure** (all of the University's global equity managers, regardless of the countries in which they invest); **Risk Reducers** (fixed income and lower volatility hedge funds); **Return Enhancers** (private equities, distressed debt, venture capital and credit opportunity funds); and **Inflation Hedges** (real estate, energy, timber, agriculture, commodities, and infrastructure).
